

## 8. OTHER BUSINESS

### 8.1 Non-payment of Affiliation fees

It was unanimously resolved on the motion put by M.Merchant/R.Underwood that any National Breed Council that has not paid its affiliation fees is suspended until their affiliation fees and all back monies owed are paid. If not paid by the next ANKC Conference they will be disaffiliated. Mrs. Wischer is to write an article for the consequences of not adhering to this requirement for publication in Member Bodies' journals.

It was unanimously resolved on the motion of W.Stacey/M. Martin that the ANKC write requesting constitution of those National Breed Councils whose constitutions are not on file with the ANKC and that the ANKC have available to the meeting the current financial reports of the breed councils..

### 8.2 Application for Intervariety matings - Belgian Shepherd Dogs

It was unanimously resolved on the motion of W.Stacey/D.Gisborne that the ANKC write to the Belgian Kennel Club and ask what the status quo is in relation to the approval of intervariety matings, i.e. where a mating of two dogs of the same variety (Malinois) throws puppies of another variety. What method do they use in dealing with this scenario?

It was unanimously resolved on the motion of S.Shrigley/W.Stacey that the ANKC will approve the intervariety mating in principal and each mating should be advised to the state kennel control who in turn will report the matter to the National Breeds Council Working Party. This matter is to be reviewed in twelve months time.

It was resolved that we ask the RAS of NSW to amend their computer to accept these matings and register the progeny from these matings for the next 12 months.

It was unanimously resolved on the motion of B.Maver/D.Gisborne that Mr. Maver will investigate the inheritance of coat type in Belgian Shepherds. Mr. Maver will report back to the ANKC Secretary as soon as he has the information available.

### 8.3 National Poodle Council Correspondence 17/10/94

It was unanimously resolved on the motion of R.Tassie/M. Martin that if Victoria has not already received permission to voice over the AKC videos that the ANKC seek permission to do so.

### 8.4 Dr. Zammit's Report on Hereditary Disease.

The report was received. It was then referred to the sub-committee and for the information of National Breed Councils where applicable.
