Please be advised that the ANKC has reaffirmed that intervariety breeding of Belgian Shepherd Dogs be retained in Australia with the recommendation that Breed Clubs educate their members on the advantages and disadvantages of intervariety breeding, together with the right reasons and / or situations for utilising it, and that the progeny should be registered according to appearance.

This decision is to be reviewed by 1 Jan 2000.
