

The Situation world wide.

Subsequent to the 2011 change in FCI policy, Germany has approved intervariety breedings with Breed club permission and German breeders have produced Groenendael x Tervueren litters.

- Sweden has reinstated intervariety breedings, effective 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2013.
- Finland allows the three requested intervariety breedings with no restrictions. Groenendael to Malinois matings may be allowed with club permission.
- Norway allows the three requested intervariety breedings with club permission.
- The UK allows intervariety matings by permission from representatives from each of the 3 breed clubs. Permission has been granted for Groenendael x Tervueren matings, Tervueren x Malinois and Laekenois x Malinois matings.
- Germany reinstated intervariety breedings effective 24<sup>th</sup> Nov 2011.<sup>i</sup>
- Intervariety matings are allowed in Ireland with consultation with the Breed Club. To date there have been Intervariety matings of Groenendael x Tervueren.
- In France, where the breed is most numerous, intervariety breedings requested are allowed with Breed club permission.
- In Italy unrestricted intervariety matings are allowed.
- In Canada there are no restrictions as to intervariety matings.

None of these countries have instigated a 3 generations clear ruling.
