The BELGIAN SHEPHERD DOG HEALTH SURVEY 2019 OUTCOMES

NOTES:

The Belgian Shepherd Dog Health Survey 2019 was undertaken as part of a Belgian Shepherd Dog Club of Queensland (BSDCQ) Grant awarded for 2019 -2020, entitled 'Future Directions: The current health status of the Belgian Shepherd Dog (BSD) within Australia.'

The purpose of the project was two-fold; to ascertain the current health status of the BSD within Australia, and to identify the frequency of any health and possible genetic issues within the BSD. This would enable breeders to make informed choices about their breeding, and breed clubs to develop any health plans (if required) to address identified health issues.

The BSD Health Survey was conducted between August and November, 2019, using the web based survey platform 'SurveyMonkey'. Electronic and paper versions of the survey form were available for those who did not wish or were unable to employ the web version. No responses were submitted in this format.

The survey was advertised by the BSDCQ, Dogs Queensland, and several other State canine bodies; it was heavily promoted on breed discussion lists within social media.

In total, **<u>520 surveys</u>** were completed. Some respondents did not complete all sections of the survey, therefore the number of responses is indicated within each section.

For the purposes of this survey, 'BSD' refers to a Belgian Shepherd Dog, regardless of gender. When gender was pertinent 'male' or 'female' was used.

The data remains confidential to the report writer and will not be shared with any other parties in its raw format.

*Percentages have been rounded up to 100%.
