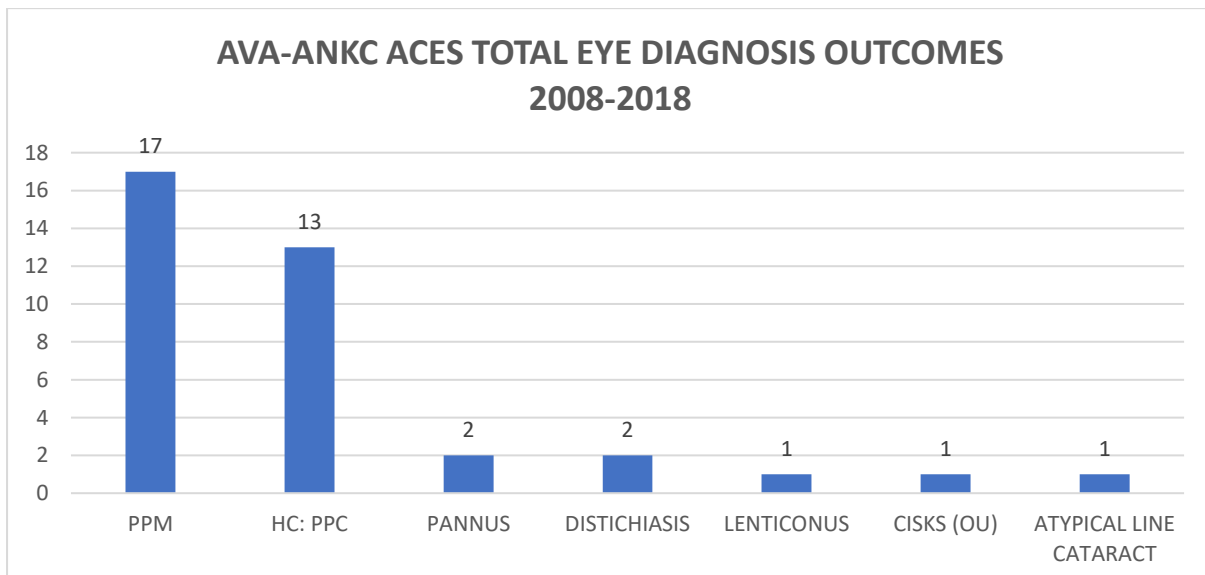
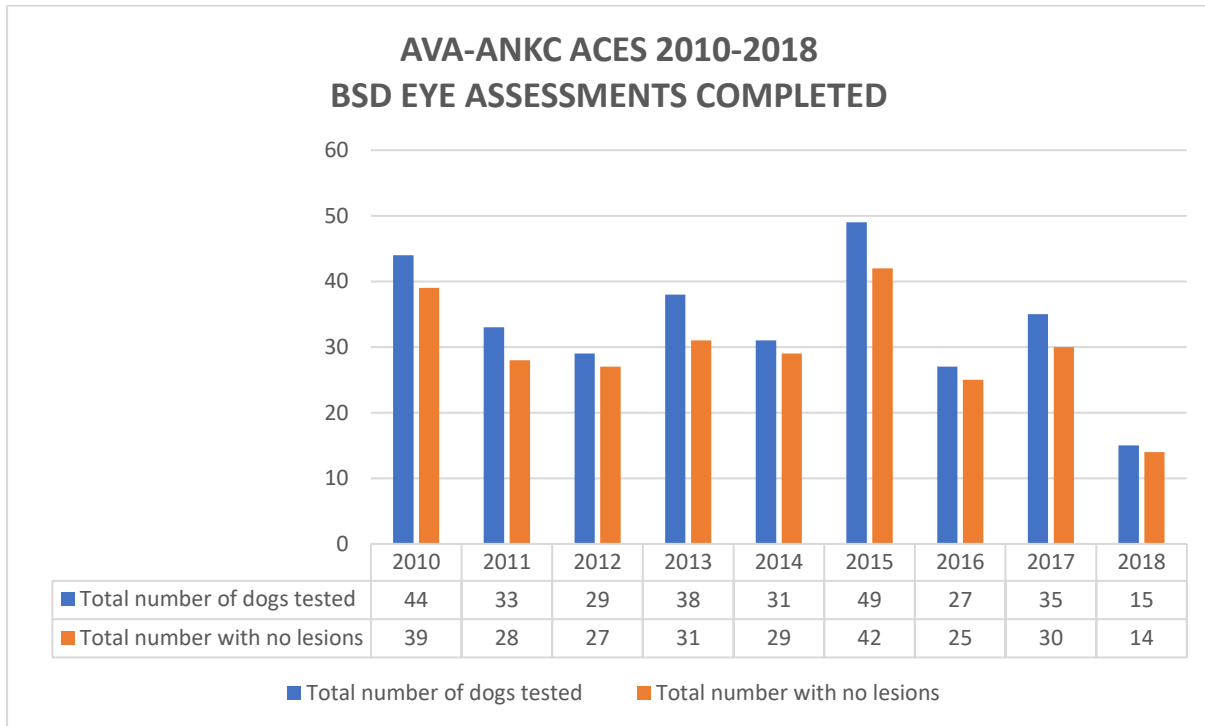

Breed comments for 2018: “Allowing for the low numbers to be expected in the Malinois and Laekenois, numbers in the more popular varieties (Groenendael & Tervueren) have dropped back somewhat this year.

Only one PPSC cataract was reported, but that is hard to interpret with such low numbers of breeding age adults being examined annually.

Breed Clubs should encourage regular ACES screening of all breeding age adults (across all four varieties) until around five to six years of age”.
